

## Snow Day Activities

Below are some **suggestions** of activities that you can do today while school is closed.

- Go for a walk and take pictures of the beautiful scenery. Look carefully at the snow on branches and leaves. Can you see the snowflakes? Use these pictures as inspiration for a piece of artwork. You can bring your artwork into school to show the rest of the class.
- Look at pictures of snowflakes. What do you notice about them? What shapes can you see? Can you design and make your own intricate and symmetrical snowflake?
- Create a poem based on winter. Maybe it could be a narrative poem. Can you include rhyming couplets, simile, metaphor, personification? Perhaps you could present it beautifully with winter themed illustrations. You could then bring it in to show the rest of the class.
- If you prefer, you could write a story set in a snowy setting. It could be adventurous, a quest or even a spooky story - it is up to you.
- I have put some winter themed maths challenge cards onto the Google Classroom. Have a go at some of these and then use the answers to mark them.
- If you still need to catch up with your My Maths, today would be a great opportunity to do this!
- Year 6, today gives you an opportunity to carry on with some revision as well!
