



## Home School Agreement

### 'Learning, Growing and Succeeding Together'

We believe our core purpose is to create a happy, secure and stimulating environment, based on mutual respect and tolerance, to educate all our children, prepare them for their futures and enable them to thrive and flourish. We want to provide an engaging and creative curriculum which inspires a lifelong love of learning and enables all children to achieve above and beyond their potential. We believe that when we work in partnership with parents and pupils we give every child the best opportunity to learn. The Home School Agreement sets out clear guidelines for expectations from the school, the parent and the pupil. By working together, we increase the chances of succeeding together.



### The School's Agreement

- To see that children are well taught, cared for and treated fairly.
- To create a warm, happy, caring, secure and stimulating environment in which children can develop and learn
- To recognise the children's strengths and achievements and ensure that they are respected as individuals.
- To encourage positive attitudes coupled with high personal standards.
- To ensure that there is clear information about the School's organisation, curriculum, teaching methods and activities through newsletters, emails, workshops, outcome events and open evenings.
- To offer parents regular information on their child's progress and to provide opportunities to meet their child's teacher on a regular basis.
- To encourage and reward good behaviour using the School's Golden Rules.
- To guide children to live the Schools values of: Inquisitiveness; Aspiration; Supportiveness; Creativity; Resilience; Independence; Reflection and Respect.
- To welcome parents into school and offer opportunities for them to become actively involved in the School.
- To safeguard children from anything which may be detrimental to their development.
- To deliver a curriculum which provides excellent learning and progress for all children.



## Parents/Carers Agreement

- To inform the School of reasons for the child's absence by 9am on the day of absence.
- To make sure that children attend regularly and on time (8:40 doors open for an 8:45 start)
- To ensure children have the correct uniform, including PE kit, and it is named.
- To take holidays during the school holidays and not during term time or accept a Penalty Notice will be issued
- To support the School's Policies, Values and Rules and encourage a positive attitude towards the School.
- To communicate with staff in a calm and respectful manner.
- To attend parents' evenings and discussions about their child's progress.
- To support children in opportunities for home learning, make sure they do their home learning and let teachers know of any problems.
- To let the School know of any changes which may affect their child's work, or behaviour.
- To let the School know of any changes to contact details or regular home time arrangements



## **The Child's Agreement**

- To come to school on time, with the things I need including PE kit and a reading book.
- To wear my school uniform correctly
- To follow the Golden Rules: Be ready; Be respectful; Be safe; Be the best you can be
- To make sure the school is a safe and friendly place in which to learn and play.

- To tell my teacher, or another adult, if anything is worrying me.
- To make the most of all the opportunities and experiences I am offered.
